Overview

Every Voice student mentoring cohorts provide an opportunity for mentoring and community for ethnic minority and Majority World students in Christian theological education. Each cohort will have a scholar-mentor who will facilitate monthly meetings (online) and provide encouragement and counsel. Monthly meetings will focus on topics such as navigating academia, developing conference papers, and best practices for success and holistic flourishing. Groups are limited to 7 students each and may include students at every level of education (undergrad–doctoral). Since these groups are designed to provide community, only committed students should apply.

Benefits

- Students who participate in cohorts will receive:
 - Community and support by other students and a scholar in the field
 - Introduction to a network of biblical scholars and theologians
 - Step-by-step guidance through the conference paper process for ETS/IBR/SBL
 - Free copies of two of the previous six Every Voice books of the month
 - A cohort dinner with your scholar-mentor at the annual meeting of ETS/IBR/SBL (for those in attendance)
